Final State Vehicle Auction of 2014 to Offer Nearly 500 Autos on Dec. 9

Preview period to run from Dec. 5 through Dec. 8

Harrisburg – As the year comes to a close, the Department of General Services will have an offering of nearly 500 vehicles for public bid during the final commonwealth vehicle auction of 2014 to be held on Tuesday, Dec. 9 at the Manheim Central Penn Auto Auction, 488 Firehouse Road, Grantville, Dauphin County at 10 a.m.

“We are closing out the year with a wide variety of vehicles for interested buyers,” state General Services Secretary Sheri Phillips said. “As always, we look to offer quality vehicles at a fair price. And with the holidays approaching, this auction is a great opportunity to find a really nice gift for someone special.”

In addition to the seized vehicles from state law enforcement agencies, trucks, SUV’s, sedans, motorcycles and other types of vehicles used by state agencies from various vehicles manufacturers will be available for bid.

A vehicle preview for the public to inspect the vehicles will take place daily from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Friday, Dec. 5 through Monday, Dec. 8, at Manheim Central Penn Auto Auction.

The auction will begin at 10 a.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 9. Registration opens at 8 a.m. and closes at noon. Buyers may purchase with cash or certified funds in the form of money orders, cashier’s checks, certified checks or bank checks – all made payable to “Manheim Central Penn Auto Auction.”

This is the final vehicle auction slated for 2014. All revenue generated is returned to the commonwealth.
