New Leadership Discusses COSTARS

Deputy Secretary and Chief Procurement Officer Share Views

We recently sat down with the new administration's Deputy Secretary for Procurement Ken Hess and Bureau of Procurement Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) Jenny Doherty to discuss COSTARS and the role that it plays in the Bureau of Procurement and the larger community. Both emphasized Governor Tom Wolf's vision of a *GOVERNMENT THAT WORKS* and cited COSTARS as an example of a program that is entrepreneurial, professional, collaborative, action-oriented and customer service focused – attributes that should to be shared by all government agencies.

As the former Director of the Bureau of Supplies and Surplus Operations (BSSO) (from 2004-11), Hess frequently traveled the commonwealth and attended local government meetings with the COSTARS marketing staff. He says it was easy to tell by the reactions of the attendees that the COSTARS program was greatly valued for the cost savings and making the procurement process simpler. Hess notes that interest and participation in the COSTARS Program has greatly increased through the years due to its marketing and training efforts, including its workshops with newly elected municipal officials. He also cited the increased availability, utilization, and improvement of Internet service to smaller municipalities. CPO Doherty also hears the "buzz" about COSTARS. "We have attended meetings where people have sung the praises of COSTARS. I think the general impression is very positive and favorable about the program," she said.

One of Deputy Secretary Hess' top priorities is to work toward forging a stronger, more cohesive partnership between the COSTARS Program, BSSO, which makes state and federal surplus property

available to local organizations, and the Bureau of Vehicle Management (BVM), which sells used state vehicles, in order to provide more value and greater cost-savings to the Local Public Procurement Units and taxpayers. He stressed the importance for government officials to use all the tools available to save taxpayer dollars. "COSTARS and BSSO are often trying to offer their services or their products to the same audience. It really should be looked at as a buffet; which meal or food appeals to me today, or which best suits my needs? Sometimes, it's going to be COSTARS and new products, other times it may be surplus property at a lower cost. So the two should complement one another and not compete. This is why the partnership between COSTARS, BSSO, and BVM is so important," he said.

Scope Expansions Clarification Contract Updates

COSTARS-38 Heavy Equipment Rental

In response to member and supplier feedback, including our latest Member Survey findings where 58 percent of respondents indicated possible usage, a new Heavy Equipment Rental COSTARS-exclusive contract bid solicitation was released on May 1, and has been posted to the COSTARS website under Bidding Opportunities. As with all COSTARS contracts, there is continuous bidding and potential suppliers are invited to submit their bids. Midland Asphalt Materials became the first awarded supplier on June 9. The scope of the contract includes short-term rental of:

- Aerial Equipment
- Air Equipment
- Compaction Equipment
- Concrete Equipment
- Earthmoving Equipment including excavators, dozers, loaders and graders
- Forest/Landscaping Equipment

- Power Generation
- Pump Equipment
- Street Sweepers
- Miscellaneous Equipment such as heaters, light towers and utility trailers
- Dump Trucks
- Highway/Road Maintenance Equipment

COSTARS-34 Theater (Auditorium) Furniture, Fixtures, Audio/Visual Equipment, & Musical Instruments

Previously, some audio visual (A/V) equipment could be found in COSTARS-3 IT Hardware and COSTARS-4 Office Supplies. In an effort to make it easier for our members to find and our suppliers to sell, we have consolidated and expanded A/V equipment within the COSTARS-34 contract. Responding to many requests over the years, we have also added musical instruments to the scope of this contract. Additional product categories include:

- Audio Equipment and Accessories: microphones, equalizers, mixers, speakers, amplifiers, sound systems, racks-multimedia, antennas, assisted listening devices, audio cassette players/recorders, CD players/recorders.
- Monitor Equipment and Accessories: A/V, DVD, TV/DVD combo, LCD, plasma, Sympodium writing tablet, TV monitors and television. All monitors must be flat panels, LCD, LED or plasma TVs.
- Camera Equipment and Accessories: camcorders, digital cameras, digital video cameras, camera support equipment, document camera, camera digital still, camera lenses, still digital cameras, tripods, monopods, lighting.
- Videoconferencing Equipment: Web-casting and capturing equipment, audio conferencing equipment.
- Presentation Equipment and Accessories: multimedia control systems, easels, screens-projection, whiteboards-electronic and copy boards, carts-A/V and stands-A/V, stage/event lighting, presentation and training aids, laser pointers, PowerPoint advancers and teaching stations.
- Projectors and Accessories.
- Video Recorders/Receivers, Video Editing Equipment and Accessories.
- Musical Instruments (Buy/Rent/Lease).

Existing A/V suppliers should transition to COSTARS-34 as their contracts renew during the next twelve months, at which time the scopes of COSTARS-3 and COSTARS-4 will be amended. COSTARS-4 Office, School, and Library Supplies

The title of the contract has been changed to reflect the broader scope, which now includes **Library Books or Print Materials, Library Non-Print Materials and Library Supplies (refer to the contract online for a complete description).** In addition, a contractor may choose to offer **Library Services** (such as cataloging and processing, machine readable cataloging, customized reports, bibliographic reports, security tape, Dewey order and bar codes) as ancillary services in conjunction with the products it provides to a purchaser.

COSTARS-12 Emergency Responder Loose Supplies

In recognition of the increased use of body and mobile cameras by law enforcement and other public safety services, the category of Public Safety Equipment and Supplies has been expanded to include **Mobile Cameras and Video Recording Equipment for In-vehicle or Body-worn Use.**

Road Paving Materials and Equipment Contracts Available to COSTARS Members

With the road construction season in full swing, did you know that COSTARS Members can piggyback off of a number of statewide asphalt paving material and construction/heavy-duty type power equipment contracts?

In fiscal year 2014-2015, COSTARS members spent nearly \$40 million on roadway maintenance materials and equipment including:

- \$23 million on the Construction Heavy-Duty Type Power Equipment contract (#4400011411).
- \$11.9 million on Bituminous Materials contracts (#561036ITQ, #5710-01 and #5610-37).
- \$2.5 million on the Aggregates and Anti-Skid Materials contract (#5610-15).
- And more than \$600,000 on the Bridge and Highway Maintenance Materials ITQ contract (CN00030482).

Additionally, COSTARS members saved nearly \$2 million in process costs (i.e., costs associated with administration, bid advertising, and contract award) and approximately \$5 million in discounted prices from suppliers, by purchasing from these COSTARS-participating contracts.

A number of asphalt paving-related contract suppliers who participate in the COSTARS Program had great things to say about the program.

Asphalt Paving

An Excerpt from American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) Regional News

Summer—it's that time of year when many of us are hitting the roads with the family. No matter how well you plan out your trip, it is almost inevitable that somewhere along the way we will all groan when we see the dreaded "Road Construction" signs. But without those paved roads, we'd be hard-pressed to get to where we want to go as quickly, or as cheaply, as we do.

Below are some interesting facts about asphalt you might want to think about next time you're stuck in road construction traffic:

- 4.1 million Approximate number of miles of public roads in the U.S. according to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). More than 253,000 of those miles are located in Pennsylvania, the state with the 11th highest number of lane miles in the U.S.
 - More than 1.3 million miles are unpaved.
 - About 1.8 million miles are paved local roads for which FHWA does not track pavement type.
 - Of the remaining 953,000 miles of paved roads, about 796,000 miles are asphalt and 158,000 miles are concrete.
- **18 billion** tons of asphalt pavements in American roads, all of which could be mined for reuse in new asphalt pavements.
 - Currently, the asphalt pavement industry reclaims more than 99 percent of asphalt pavement removed from projects for reuse in future projects.
- 65 percent of the asphalt pavement market is identified in publically funded highway projects.
- **80 million** tons of asphalt pavements are recycled annually the most recycled material in the United States—more than glass, metal, tires, paper or any other material.
- \$1 The FHWA estimates that each dollar spent on road, highway and bridge improvements results in a payback of \$5.20 in reduced vehicle, road and bridge maintenance costs, reduced delays, reduced fuel consumption, improved safety and reduced emissions.
- \$300 million per year is saved by American taxpayers through asphalt recycling. Asphalt cuts road construction time.*

Hess reminds us that a downside to today's technology is that many buyers are reliant on the Amazon.com® model, where they can go to one place and find everything, and that may not necessarily be the best value approach. COSTARS, BSSO, and BVM require the buyers to be more engaged and search in several places on the Department of General Services website. These programs must continue to provide outreach through online educational training modules, workshops, and webinars while ensuring their tools are simple and easy to use, Hess says. He also stressed the importance of using technology to deliver information and training, such as social media and YouTube. The COSTARS Program has introduced training simulations on the COSTARS website and is looking to expand the training materials available to our members and suppliers,

including webinars. Earlier this year, COSTARS joined Facebook and Twitter.

CPO Doherty also discussed the need for internal education within state agencies about these programs. She said there is still some confusion in exactly how COSTARS works. "I think if you said to someone in state government 'what is COSTARS?', they would tell you it is the commonwealth's cooperative purchasing program, but may not be able to tell you how it works specifically," Doherty said. She applauded a recent workshop presented by COSTARS, BSSO, and BVM to associates of the Bureau of Procurement. "It was terrific. I think doing some workshops like this with different state agencies would be a great internal marketing opportunity. This would help the program to grow in popularity and understanding. I know COSTARS is getting out to the communities and marketing, but even just marketing internally to the different state agencies would be good to spread the word so they can start talking about it at the local level," she said.

Doherty also emphasized the dual nature of COSTARS' cost savings. "The COSTARS Program helps the state to leverage and increase the volume of our statewide contracts and achieve greater cost-savings, and municipalities also are able to leverage that buying power. It also provides great business opportunities for the small business community to be able to either compete on a statewide contract or bid on a COSTARS-exclusive contract. Members have the option to use a statewide contract or keep their tax dollars in their local economy with a COSTARS-exclusive contract. It's a terrific program. COSTARS is just an actual extension of what we are all working toward. It helps to contribute to the notion of having a government that works and provides value to the local governments, our suppliers, the state government, and taxpayers," Doherty said.

Hess urged authorized suppliers to use COSTARS tools to proactively market their companies to differentiate themselves among their competitors, such as implementing promotions or "sales". "Perhaps, we'll look at advertising opportunities on the COSTARS website," he suggested.

"COSTARS is a great program," Hess added. "I think it is highly valued and I can only predict really good things, assuming we stay attuned to the needs of our respective markets and customers, employ the technology that's available to us, and employ 'out of the box' thinking."

2015-16 Road Salt Contract Awarded By Bruce Beardsley, COSTARS Marketing Manger

The Department of General Services (DGS) has announced most of the awarded suppliers for the commonwealth's Sodium Chloride road salt contract for 2015-2016. At press time, the award for nine counties remains under review.

This year, DGS used a "reverse auction," which reduced prices by \$10 million, compared to the suppliers' original bids. With this more aggressive methodology, the average price to PennDOT and COSTARS members is approximately 12 percent more than last year, due to increased market pricing.

"The current market of supply and demand dictates the pricing," said Ed Myslewicz, the DGS Bureau of Procurement commodity manager in charge of the road salt contract. "Last year's severe winter has pinched national stockpiles and depleted inventories, resulting in higher prices for consumers this year," he added.

There is a notable customer service improvement to this year's contract. Unlike last year, all COSTARS members, regardless of stockpile capacity, will be able to place their orders starting Aug. 1 (with the exception of the nine counties under review as of press time. They include McKean, Potter, Tioga, Bradford, Lycoming, Sullivan, Montour, Columbia and Northumberland).

Orders placed between Aug. 1 and Oct. 31 are subject to a 30-day delivery requirement. **COSTARS members are strongly urged to order their salt as soon as possible after Aug. 1.**

A record 1,655 COSTARS members are participating in this year's road salt contract (71 more than the previous year). COSTARS members' requested tonnage increased 9.8 percent to a record 909,951 tons.

The contract will be posted on or about Aug. 1 to the COSTARS website and available for viewing at the **Members** page under **Current News.**

In addition to the above-mentioned statewide contracts, members may also rent heavy equipment for all of their roadway maintenance needs from a new COSTARS-exclusive contract - COSTARS-38 Heavy Equipment Rental. Equipment available to rent through this contract includes: aerial equipment; earthmoving equipment; highway/road maintenance equipment; power generation equipment; dump trucks; etc.

Members should consider COSTARS-38 and statewide COSTARS-participating asphalt paving material and construction heavy-duty type power equipment contracts for future roadway maintenance projects. Then select COSTARS or Statewide Contract search via the Search Contracts link on the left-hand side of the page.



The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation's (PennDOT) Municipal Fuels Program funds a range of projects to support municipalities' construction, reconstruction, maintenance and repair of public roads or streets. The amount of a municipality's allocation is based on its population and miles of roads on their approved Liquid Fuels Inventory.

Municipalities may use liquid fuels funds to purchase commodities essential to completing these projects; such as aggregates, guard rails, highway support vehicles, sodium chloride, etc., via the COSTARS Program.

Although the Municipal Fuels Program and COSTARS are not related and are administered by different agencies, they complement each other by providing a means for municipalities to save money on road or street construction projects.

Sales Reporting

The COSTARS Program requires participating suppliers to report their COSTARS member sales on a quarterly basis. To electronically report your sales follow the steps below:



- 1. Go to the Supplier Portal
- 2. Select Log On in the upper right-hand corner
- 3. Select the Bidder tab at the top of the page.
- 4. Select the Enterprise Applications link on the left-hand side of the page.
- 5. If a Security Warning pop-up box appears, select No or Show All Content.
- Select the COSTARS link at the top of the page to access your Vendor Dashboard.
- 7. Select the Report Sales link that corresponds to the contract for which you would like to submit a report.

Troubleshooting Tips

Below are some helpful troubleshooting tips to try if you are not able to access the Enterprise Applications page with the COSTARS link.

- 1. Ensure you're using Internet Explorer version 8 through 11.
- 2. Go back one page, then re-enter and select the Bidder tab and Enterprise Applications link again.
- 3. Delete your browsing history by selecting Internet Explorer Tools/Internet Options, then select Delete under the Browsing History heading.
- 4. Ensure your pop-up blocker is turned off.


