PA DCED	<a href="#">(NEW) \$225 Million Small Business Grant Program</a>	This statewide grant program will support small businesses that were impacted by the COVID-19 public health crisis and subsequent business closure order. The Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) will distribute the funds to the Community Development Financial Institutions (CDFIs), which will then administer the funding in the form of grants. Eligible businesses will be able to use the grants to cover operating expenses during the shutdown and transition to re-opening, and for technical assistance including training and guidance for business owners as they stabilize and relaunch their businesses.

US SBA	<a href="#">Paycheck Protection Program</a>	The Paycheck Protection Program is a loan designed to provide a direct incentive for small businesses to keep their workers on the payroll. SBA will forgive loans if all employees are kept on the payroll for eight weeks and the money is used for payroll, rent, mortgage interest, or utilities.
