DIALING INFORMATION

CALLING WITHIN PENNCONNECT IPT LOCATIONS

- A. To make a local call or long distance call, dial the 10-digit number. (Area Code + 7-Digit Number)
- B. To dial a toll free call, dial the 10-digit number.

Please note: In September 2017, the 717 area code will receive an overlay of the 223 area code. Starting August 2017, all users in the 717 area code must use 10-digit dialing. For questions, please contact your agency's telecommunications office.

CALLING WITHIN NON-PENNCONNECT LOCATIONS

Follow your dialing plan for local and long distance or inquire with your agency's telecommunications office.

PENNCONNECT VOICEMAIL ACCESS

System A:

- 1. Dial 717-612-4799
- 2. Enter your mailbox 11-digit mailbox number (1+Area Code+7-Digit Number)
- 3. Enter your PIN

System B:

- 1. Dial 717-612-4739
- 2. Enter your mailbox 11-digit mailbox number (1+Area Code+7-Digit Number)
- 3. Enter your PIN

DIRECTORY ASSISTANCE

Check your dialing plan to determine any leading digits (9 or 1).

- A. Local Dial 555-1212.
- B. Long Distance Dial Area Code + 555-1212 OR 411, if applicable.

THREATENING CALLS

Threatening or harassing calls can be traced by the phone company provided the user or agency agrees to file a complaint with law enforcement. Call details will only be given to law enforcement officials.

- A. Once the call in question is over hang up your phone.
- B. Pick up your handset and listen for dial tone.
- C. Dial *57 and hang up.
- D. Call your agency's telecommunications office and report the date and time of the call.

CONFERENCE CALLING

Audio and Web Collaboration services are available via the PennConnect Conferencing tool. Audio and Web Collaboration sessions can be scheduled for up to 300 participants.
