Part II Chapter 35 Surcharge Program

- A. It is the policy of DGS to ensure that delivered materials meet all specifications and are delivered on time. The procedures in <u>Part II Chapter 33, Material Inspection</u> and <u>Part II Chapter 34, Late Delivery of Ordered Materials</u> must be followed.
- **B.** When a supplier fails to make timely delivery of a material or has had a material rejected and has not replaced it with an acceptable material within a reasonable period of time, it may be necessary for the purchasing agency to procure materials on the open market and to surcharge the defaulting supplier for any cost difference.
