# **REQUEST FOR INFORMATION**

- Can SCI Fayette provide boiler logs from Fayette Thermal for hourly or daily production?
   SCI Fayette does not have any boiler logs.
- 2. Please provide a copy of a current invoice for sewer use and electricity use. **See**Attachment A, of this bulletin, for a sewer invoice and Attachment B, of this invoice, for an electricity invoice.
- 3. Are there any existing control system drawings that we may review at SCI Fayette? The available drawings for the Building Automation Controls are attached as Attachment C of this bulletin.
- 4. Please elaborate on the existing ventilation issues relating to Dietary and K-Block. The ventilation system in Dietary and "K" block is not sufficient enough to exhaust the steam out of the dish rooms and the inmate bathroom on "K" block. These rooms become extremely hot when they are washing the trays in dietary and the inmates are showering on "K" block.
- 5. Could you please clarify whether steam and associated payments (e.g. parts, supplies, wages, etc.) can be used in the cost savings calculations? Especially in light of the "without usage of O&M savings or energy related cost savings" language in the Scoring Matrix for ECM/Cost Submission. Assuming that the "steam and associated payments" is referring to the contracted steam services then yes, these can be included in the savings calculations.
- 6. Does the Department of Corrections or DGS have a preferred tubular LED technology (i.e. Type A, B, or C)? **No; type A & B are currently being used on site.**
- 7. Do current back-up generators support 100% of the prison's electrical loads during a power outage? **Currently, yes.**

- 8. It appears that an arc flash study was done on switchgear SG3 in the central plant. Is it possible to obtain a copy of the study? **Unfortunately, SCI Fayette does not have any records concerning this study.**
- 9. Please provide steam consumption based on steam meter readings by Fayette Thermal. Is it possible to obtain hourly steam use data from Fayette Thermal? **The last two (2)** months bills for Fayette Thermal are attached as Attachment D of this bulletin. SCI Fayette pays Fayette Thermal for 11,666,67 K lbs. of steam every month.
- 10. What is the operational season of the SCI Fayette absorption chillers? Does the facility require cooling in winter, or do they only operate May-October, for example? **The chillers are typically running May through October.**
